Trimesters & Holidays

EXACT DATES OF HOLIDAYS AND TRIMESTER BREAKS WILL BE ANNOUNCED BY
BEGINNING OF SEPTEMBER 2022.

Our students attend public and private schools in Canton Vaud and Geneva so Holiday
schedules range widely.

We look at all the schedules (private and public) and create one that works for most of our
students.

*Course fees take holidays and trimester breaks into account. We hold no regular classes
during holidays.*

No classes during the week of the ballet show.

Payments & Fees

SIGN UP FEES

CURRENT STUDENTS **CHF 20.-**

There is a sign up fee for each new school year for students who have attended Piri Ballet classes in the past: CHF 20.-. This fee will be added to the first invoice.

FIRST TIME STUDENTS **CHF 90.-**

CHF 40.- new student sign up fee + CHF 100+ value uniform package for CHF 50.-

This CHF 90.- fee includes the CHF 40.- sign up fee for new students PLUS a welcome package with all their uniform requirements: Leotard, ballet shoes, ballet tights & Hair equipment (value CHF 100+). This way we save you the hassle of getting everything you need for your new ballet dancer plus you are receiving a huge discount! This fee will be added to the first invoice.

TRIMESTER PAYMENTS (1 class / week)

1st Trimester: CHF 396.-

2nd Trimester: CHF 387.-

3rd Trimester: CHF 207.-

Invoices are set up per trimester unless you let us know otherwise. When signing up, we are holding that spot for you for the whole school year unless you let us know otherwise (see cancellations on page 4).

Monthly payments are possible with a 10% extra charge (average of CHF 109 per month). Please let us know if you would prefer to pay monthly. Same cancellation policy applies to monthly payments as trimester payments (see cancellations on page 4).

OTHER FEES

Show Participation Fee (see page 6): CHF 49.- (added to 3rd trimester invoice)

Changing to another Class: CHF 0.- (before 19.9.2022)
CHF 20.- (after 19.9.2022)

Cancellation Fee (see page 5): CHF 0 (before 19.9.2022)
CHF 39.- (after 19.9.2022)

FAMILY & 2nd CLASS DISCOUNT

The second child will receive a 10% discount on their classes. The third child will also receive a 10% discount on their classes. Same discount applies when one child attends 2 classes per week: the second class will cost 10% less.

Family Discount: 10%

Additional Class Discount: 10%

You will receive the invoices from us per **email**. When you sign up all invoices are sent out for the whole school year at once but due dates vary. You can choose to make your payment per card, cash or bank transfer.

1st Trimester: Invoice due **5th October 2022**

2nd Trimester: Invoice due **5th December 2023**

3rd Trimester: Invoice due **5th April 2023**

Please note that no additional deductions are made from course fees for holidays as those are already taken into account.

Payments Options

CARD *2.9% card fees apply*

- 1) Click on top right hand corner of invoice
- 2) Follow steps until check out

CASH *0% fees*

- 1) Deduct the card fee from invoice
- 2) Put payment in a sealed **envelope** and write your **full name on it**
- 3) Give this envelope to the teacher before or after class
- 4) The teacher will give you a receipt

BANK TRANSFER *0% fees*

- 1) Deduct the card fee from invoice
- 1) Add your **INVOICE NUMBER** in subject when making transfer

LATE PAYMENTS

There is a charge of **CHF 20.-** for payments that are **30 days late**.

CHF 20.- will be charged **extra for each 30 days** a payment is late.

Cancellation

When signing up, we are holding that spot for you for the whole school year unless you let us know otherwise. Cancellations can be made for the following trimester(s) ahead of time only.

CANCELLATION DATES

1. Trimester: Cancel before 19 September 2022
2. Trimester: Cancel before 5 December 2022
3. Trimester: Cancel before 5 April 2023

CANCELLATION FEE CHF 39.-

There is a cancellation fee of CHF 39.- if you decide to discontinue mid-school year. Cancellations before 19 September 2022 incur no fees. Cancellations are only accepted when given in writing (email contact@piriballet.ch) by the dates given above.

INJURY & SICKNESS

In case of injury, you must **notify us immediately** if your child can not participate for **3+** classes. If your child **misses 3 or less classes, no need to notify us**. We do not provide refunds but we may be able to arrange some make-up classes together. Sometimes your insurance company can refund you for missed classes because of prolonged injury or sickness. Check this with your insurance.

CANCELLED CLASSES

In case of sickness (teacher) and/or other unforeseeable emergencies on our side, we reserve the right to cancel classes for which you will receive make-up classes as a compensation.

Ballet Show

We are excited to give our students and audience an experience they will remember and cherish with a big end of year show! The theme will be Alice in wonderland.



The show will be on stage at Theatre de Marens in full costume, ballet hair and stage makeup.

PARTICIPATION

Participation is not obligatory but highly encouraged. Each student will be **automatically in the show** unless you let us know otherwise (by Jan '23).

Exact dates and times will be announced by January 2023 but please block all the below dates in your calendar. Your child will most likely only need to rehearse and perform on one of these dates (one rehearsal and one performance).

OBLIGATORY REHEARSAL DATES: 3, 4 & 7 June 2023

PERFORMANCE DATES: 9, 10 & 11 June 2023

ENTRANCE FEE: CHF 15-35.- per ticket

SHOW PARTICIPATION FEE: CHF 49.-

The show participation fee covers some of the cost of the costume rental and professional video recording (with unlimited access). The costume rental fee (renting from us) covers the: wear and tear, washing, steaming, size adjustment etc (we keep the costumes) of the costume your child will be wearing in the show.

Rules

Our rules are here to create better quality classes for your children. We want to eliminate any unnecessary distractions and keep a unified and respectful environment.

RESPECT

Creating a respectful environment throughout our school is important to us.

Students must be respectful towards teachers and other students and of course our teachers are respectful towards our students.

We ask parents to always speak to our teachers with respect and patience as they are doing their best. Our teachers are always happy to receive feedback in a positive manner. Feedback is always very welcome at Piri Ballet, as we continually strive to improve our school and your feedback helps us greatly to do this.

UNIFORM

Uniforms are set for each level and obligatory to wear weekly. You can buy that uniform from us on our webshop or at any other dance shop as long as it meets our requirements. NO JEWELRY

Only small earrings are allowed. Please make sure to take off all armbands, necklaces etc before class. Again, it helps eliminate distraction and it is safer.

WATER BOTTLE

Please make sure your child has a water bottle to drink from during class. Only water is allowed in the classroom. No other drinks or food are allowed in the studio.

HAIR

Children with neatly tied back hair into a ballet bun take themselves and the class more seriously.

Hair that is not done properly is one of the biggest distractions in class for the student.

Their hair needs to be neatly tied back in a ballet bun. Use hair clips so all the hair is tied back. If hair is too short for a ponytail, please use a hair band.

WHEN ARRIVING LATE

If you arrive late, please wait for the music to stop before you enter. It is very distracting for the class to have someone enter in the middle of an exercise.

STAY HOME WHEN SICK

Please do not bring your children to class when they have anything contagious or if they are unwell. You can use make-up classes for missed classes because of sickness.

STAY IF CHILD NEEDS HELP WITH TOILET

Please make sure that the child has gone to the toilet before class. If your child can not yet use the toilet by themselves, stay or ask another parent to help your child.

Responsibilities

1. By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions legal representatives of students hereby represent and warrant that they are sufficiently physically fit to participate in the training offered by Piri Ballet, and that they have no medical condition that would prevent their participation.
2. Students are advised not to undertake strenuous physical activity without first seeking medical advice if they have concerns over their physical condition and wellbeing. Our teachers are not medically qualified so if you have any doubts about your child's physical condition, wellbeing and capability to exercise, we strongly recommend that you get advice from a doctor first.
3. It is the students legal representative's sole responsibility to notify Piri Ballet before attending any session of any circumstances affecting their health.
4. Piri Ballet does not cover the risks of illness and accidents. Each student must be insured personally.
5. Piri Ballet is not liable for any and all damages, accidents, injuries, injuries caused or suffered during lessons or during shows.
6. Piri Ballet is not liable for any thefts in the dressing room and inside the studio. It is advisable to leave no valuables.
7. Piri Ballet will always seek the safety of its students and that is why, we ask you to always have your child accompanied by an adult at the beginning and at the end of the lesson. Please make sure to arrive shortly before the class finishes.
