Payments & Fees

SIGN UP FEE ANNUALLY CHF 30.-

CLASS FEES (10 monthly instalments)

Levels (approx ages 2.5-4.5): 45 mins class MONTHLY CHF 89.-

Modern & Levels Monthly CHF 119.-

Pointe 1 & 2: 30 mins class MONTHLY CHF 60.-

If you would like to pay annually (10x monthly at once) you receive a 10% discount.

LATE PAYMENTS

There is a charge of CHF 20.- for payments that are 30 days late.

CHF 20.- will be charged extra for each 30 days a payment is late.

Cancellation

When signing up, we are holding that spot for you for the whole school year unless you let us know otherwise.

CANCELLATION DATES

Cancel anytime with <u>minimum 60 days notice</u>. Payments are due until the end of the month after the 60 days.

Example: if you cancel mid-October you pay until the end of December. If you cancel on the 1st of October, you pay until the end of November.

CANCELLATION FEE CHF 39.-

There is a cancellation fee of CHF 39.- if you decide to discontinue mid-school year. Cancellations before 15 September 2023 incur no fees. Cancellations are only accepted when given in writing email: contact@piriballet.ch by the dates given above.

INJURY & SICKNESS

In case of illness, **no need to notify us**. We do not provide refunds but we may be able to arrange some make-up classes together. In case of injury, you must **notify us immediately** if your child can not participate in **3**+ classes. Sometimes your insurance company can refund you for missed classes because of prolonged injury or sickness. Check this with your insurance.

CANCELLED CLASSES

In case of sickness (teacher) and/or other unforeseeable emergencies on our side, we reserve the right to cancel classes for which you will receive make-up classes as a compensation if possible.

Ballet Shows

We are excited to give our students and audience an experience they will remember and cherish! All rehearsals and shows will be on stage at **Theatre de Marens**, **Nyon** in full costume, ballet hair and stage makeup.

Exact dates and times will be announced by January 2024 but please block all the below dates in your calendar. Your child will most likely only need to rehearse and perform on one of these dates (one rehearsal and one performance). No classes at the ballet school during rehearsal week.

SPRING SHOW

Participation is not obligatory but highly encouraged. Each student will be <u>automatically in the show</u> unless you let us know by January 15, 2024.

OBLIGATORY REHEARSAL DATES: 1-9 June 2024

PERFORMANCE DATES: 8 & 9 June 2024

ENTRANCE FEE: CHF 10-35.-per ticket Available through Ticketcorner

SHOW PARTICIPATION FEE: CHF 49.-

The show participation fee covers some of the cost of the costumes, props, and professional video recording (with unlimited access). This also helps cover some of the fees for: wear and tear, repairs, washing, steaming, size adjustment etc. We keep the costume your child will be wearing in the show. There will be plenty of time between the shows for you to take photos of and with your child in the costume.



Rules

Our rules are here to create better quality classes for your children. We want to eliminate any unnecessary distractions and keep a unified and respectful environment.

RESPECT

Creating a respectful environment throughout our school is important to us.

Students must be respectful towards teachers and other students and of course our teachers are respectful towards our students.

We ask parents to always speak to our teachers with respect and patience as they are doing their best. Our teachers are always happy to receive feedback in a positive manner. Feedback is always very welcome at Piri Ballet, as we continually strive to improve our school and your feedback helps us greatly to do this.

UNIFORM

Uniforms are set for each level and obligatory to wear weekly. You can buy that uniform from us on our webshop or at any other dance shop as long as it meets our requirements. NO JEWELLERY

Only small earrings are allowed. Please make sure to take off all armbands, necklaces etc before class. Again, it helps eliminate distraction and it is safer.

WATER BOTTLE

Please make sure your child has a water bottle to drink from during class. Only water is allowed in the classroom. No other drinks or food are allowed in the studio.

HAIR

Children with neatly tied back hair into a ballet bun take themselves and the class more seriously.

Hair that is not done properly is one of the biggest distractions in class for the student.



Their hair needs to be neatly tied back in a ballet bun. Use hair clips so all the hair is tied back. If hair is too short for a ponytail, please use a hair band.

WHEN ARRIVING LATE

If you arrive late, please wait for the music to stop before you enter. It is very distracting for the class to have someone enter in the middle of an exercise.

STAY HOME WHEN SICK

Please do not bring your children to class when they have anything contagious or if they are unwell. You can use make-up classes for missed classes because of sickness.

STAY IF CHILD NEEDS HELP WITH TOILET

Please make sure that the child has gone to the toilet before class. If your child can not yet use the toilet by him/herself, stay or ask another parent to help your child.

Responsibilities

- By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions legal representatives of students hereby represent and warrant that they are sufficiently physically fit to participate in the training offered by Piri Ballet, and that they have no medical condition that would prevent their participation.
- 2. Students are advised not to undertake strenuous physical activity without first seeking medical advice if they have concerns over their physical condition and wellbeing. Our teachers are not medically qualified so if you have any doubts about your child's physical condition, wellbeing and capability to exercise, we strongly recommend that you get advice from a doctor first.
- 3. It is the students legal representative's sole responsibility to notify Piri Ballet before attending any session of any circumstances affecting their health.
- 4. Piri Ballet does not cover the risks of illness and accidents. Each student must be insured personally.
- 5. Piri Ballet is not liable for any and all damages, accidents, injuries caused or suffered during lessons or during shows.
- 6. Piri Ballet is not liable for any thefts in the dressing room and inside the studio. It is advisable to leave no valuables.
- 7. Piri Ballet will always seek the safety of its students and that is why, we ask you to always have your child accompanied by an adult at the beginning and at the end of the lesson. Please make sure to arrive shortly before the class finishes.
